

ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK NINE

On the authority of 'Abū Hurayrah, may Allāh be pleased with him, who said: The Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh's blessings and peace be upon him, said:

“Surely Allāh is ṭayyib (pure) and accepts only that which is ṭayyib (pure). Surely Allāh commanded the believers to do that which He commanded the Messengers. The Exalted has said, “O Messengers, eat of the ṭayyibāt (pure) and perform righteous deeds,” [23:51] and The Exalted has said, “O you who believed, eat of the ṭayyibāt (pure) that We have provided for you” [2:172]. Then he mentioned a man who, having journeyed far, is disheveled and dusty, and who spreads out his hands to the sky saying, “O Lord! O Lord!” while his food is ḥarām (unlawful), his drink is ḥarām, his clothing is ḥarām, and he has been nourished with ḥarām. How can he be answered?”
