

# ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK TWENTY-EIGHT

On the authority of the father of Tha'labah al-Khushaniyy, Jurthūm, the son of Nāshir, may Allāh be pleased with him, that the Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh's blessings and peace be upon him, said:
