

## ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK THIRTY-THREE

On the authority of 'Abū Hurayrah, may Allāh be pleased with him, who said: the Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh's blessings and peace be upon him said:

**“Do not envy one another. Do not bid against one another, increasing prices. Do not hate one another. Do not turn away from one another. Do not undercut one another in trade. Be slaves of Allāh, brothers.**

**A Muslim is the brother of a Muslim. He does not oppress him. He does not lie to him. He does not look down on him with disdain.**

**Taqwā is right here—and he pointed to his chest three times.**

**It is evil enough for a man to look down on his Muslim brother with disdain.**

**The whole of a Muslim is inviolable for another Muslim: his blood, his property, and his honor.”**
