

ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK THIRTY-FOUR

On the authority of 'Abū Hurayrah, may Allāh be pleased with him, that the Prophet, may Allāh's blessings and peace be upon him, said:

“Whoever removes a worldly distress from a believer, Allah will remove from him one of the distresses of the Day of Rising. Whoever alleviates for a needy person, Allah will alleviate for him in this world and the hereafter. Whoever shields a Muslim, Allah will shield him in this world and the hereafter. Allāh will aid His slave so long as he aids his brother.

Whoever follows a path to seek knowledge therein, Allāh will make easy for him a path to Paradise.

No people gather together in one of the houses of Allāh, reciting the Book of Allāh, studying it among themselves, except that tranquility descends upon them, mercy envelops them, the angels surround them, and Allāh mentions them amongst those who are with Him.

Whoever is slowed down by his actions will not be hastened forward by his lineage.”
