

# ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK FORTY-FOUR

On the authority of ‘Abdu l-Lāh, the son of Busr, may Allāh be pleased with him, who said:

“A man came to the Messenger of Allah, may Allāh’s blessings and peace be upon him, and said, ‘O Messenger of Allāh, the laws of ‘Islām have become too many for us, so [what is] a complete means of access onto which we can hold? He said, ‘**Let not your tongue stop being moist with the remembrance of Allāh ‘Azza wa Jall.**’”

It was related by al-‘Imām ‘Aḥmad with this wording.
