

# MORNING AND EVENING DU‘Ā’ – ALL UNITS

On the authority of the father of Mālik (may Allāh be pleased with him), that the Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh’s blessings and peace be upon him, said:  
“**Whenever one of you enters upon the morning, let him say:**

**’aṣḥaḥnā wa ’aṣḥaḥa l-mulku li l-lāhi rabbi l-’ālamīn, al-lāhumma ’innī ’as’aluka khayra hādha l-yawm, faṭḥahū wa naṣrahū wa nūrahū wa barakatahū wa hudāh, wa ’a’ūdhu bika min sharri mā fīhi wa sharri mā ba’dah.**

**We have entered upon the morning and all dominion, which belongs to Allāh, Master of all creation. O Allāh, I ask you for the goodness of this day—its victory, its help, its light, its blessing, and its guidance. I take refuge in you from the evil of what is in it and the evil of what follows it.**

Then when he enters upon the evening, let him say similar to that.”

It was related by Abū Dāwūd.

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When you enter upon the evening, say:

**’amsaynā wa ’amsa l-mulku li l-lāhi rabbi l-’ālamīn, al-lāhumma ’innī ’as’aluk khayra hādhihi l-laylah, faṭḥahā wa naṣrahā wa nūrahā wa barakatahā wa hudāhā, wa ’a’ūdhu bika min sharri mā fīhā wa sharri mā ba’dahā.**

**We have entered upon the evening and all dominion, which belongs to Allāh, Master of all creation. O Allāh, I ask you for the goodness of this evening—its victory, its help, its light, its blessing, and its guidance. I take refuge in you from the evil of what is in it and the evil of what follows it.**
